






HOW TO ADD THE BSC NETWORK TO METAMASK

Open your Metamask extension


- 1) To add a network, click on "Ethereum mainnet" in the top right






2) Click on »Add network« below


- 3) Find or type »BNB Smart Chain (previously Binance Smart Chain Mainnet)« in the search bar





5) Click »Approve«, to add the network

6) Switch to BNB Smart Chain






7) Then click on »Got it«







10) The »Import tokens« window will open

12) When you paste the address, the rest fills out automatically

13) Then click on »Add custom token«






14) To finish, click on »Import tokens«
